#### Introduction

- A. What are the ways we get information in our lives? How can we be sure the information is accurate?
- B. Theme of 2 Timothy: Persevere in the gospel despite opposition and suffering (1:8, 14)

### I. Paul received the faith from others (1:3)

- A. He begins with thanksgiving What is significant about this considering Paul's circumstances?
- B. He is continuing the message the Old Testament saints believed
  - 1. How were all the sacrifices of the OT an expression of the hope of the gospel?
  - 2. What was Paul announcing then with the coming of Jesus? (Hebrews 10:1-5, 14)
  - 3. Was Paul's message any different from that of the other Apostles? (Acts 4:12; 2 Peter 3:15-16)

# II. Timothy received the faith through his family (1:5)

- A. How had Timothy heard the gospel message?
  - 1. What do we know about Timothy's family? (Acts 16:1)
  - 2. What was Paul's first visit to Timothy's hometown like? (Acts 14:8-20)
- B. Our first mission field is our own family

  How do we pass the torch of the gospel to those in our own family?

  (Deuteronomy 6:4-9; Ephesians 6:4)

# III. Timothy needs to carry this faith into the future (1:6-7; 2:2)

- A. What does Paul tell Timothy to do in verse 6?
- B. Why do you think Paul needed to say this to Timothy?
- C. What in our lives tends to put out our spiritual flame?
